

## Anaesthetic report.

Total Anaesthetics given 54.

Emergency Anaesthetics - War casualties - 19 ~~or 20~~  
- Other - 10

Endotracheal intubations - 43

Relaxant (non-depolarizing) - 6

IV. alone (barbiturate) - 2

Nembutal - 1

No anaesthetic deaths or complications occurred.

## Technique.

(1) The "haloxaine" was used exclusively.

(2) ~~Spontaneous~~ Where appropriate pre-anaesthetic resuscitation was carried out with large quantities of Hartmann's solution and blood "off the hoof" when needed.

(3) ~~The~~ The basic technique used has been kept simple

in order to assist technicians. Oxygen, air and halothane supplemented with IV pethidine has been used in the majority of the cases. In relaxant cases, the patients were paralysed with alioferim and manually inflated with oxygen, air and 0.5% halothane.
