1. Four "abdominal" cases were anaesthetised, none of whom were "war" wounded. One LSCS was performed.
2. One scolime apnoea was observed in a man of Jebali origin.
3. One death occurred, ~~whilst under anaesthetic~~ of a severe head injury, whilst under anaesthetic. The anaesthetic was not considered to be the cause of death.
4. It is noted that in "Resupply Box No 4 Anaesthetic / Drugs resupply for 50 patients" the non-depolarizing muscle relaxant, tubarine, is included. However the box does NOT contain any antagonist, i.e. neostigmine. Can this please be rectified in future resupply?
