Many thanks for the fascinating and hospitable week in Salalah. Since returning I have been to see the ADMS here and outlined those points which were stressed and in particular Gerry Haney's plea for wising up the PMO.

I enclose some seeds which I hope will flourish in the Salalah green belt.

As regards that neck lump, the clinical impression of thyroid was confirmed and it was histologically a well differentiated papillary adenocarcinoma of the lateral aberrant type, on which basis I should have thought that it might respond well to high doses of thyroxine.

I should be very grateful of a note about the outcome of the cases who came in during my stay and also for copies of the photographs when they are processed.
