

There is a lot of publicity at present about Bands being on the way back, but there are a select few who because of a constant demand, have never been away. Amongst these are TERRY LIGHTFOOT AND HIS BAND.

It is always a temptation when writing about a bandleader of Terry Lightfoot's reputation and ability to constantly refer to his past achievements, which are numerous, but while it provides the backcloth for experience that gives his present band such a firm foundation it must not be allowed to overshadow in any way the fact that TERRY LIGHTFOOT AND HIS BAND as of today is the best Band that has ever carried that title.

Terry has enjoyed success for over a decade but despite past achievements he cannot remember any single time when the prestige and musical ability of the Band has been greater. They are regularly booked all over the United Kingdom for places as far apart as Thurso in the North of Scotland to St. Ives in Cornwall. In the last year they have toured both East and West Germany (where they are already booked again for this April), performed concerts in Gibraltar and Cyprus and recently made a return visit to the Island of Gan in the Indian Ocean. They also had an enjoyable appearance on Television in the Wheeltappers and Shunters Show and are regularly heard on Radio. They have three L.P.'s released over the last couple of years and are at the moment planning to have a new single out plus an L.P.

Musically Terry has always trod a path he feels best without being hidebound by conventional barriers, and therefore is now able to offer a greater variety of programme. This has in turn brought him to a wider audience that has resulted in the Band enjoying a greater popularity than ever before.

Terry has always been a great one for sidemen (Kenny Ball, John Bennett, Roy Williams and Dickie Hawdon to name but a few), but he considers his present aggregation to be his best ever!

For relaxation Terry has always chosen sporting pursuits, with Football being the most prominent. That was until about three years ago, when he first started horse riding. He found he thoroughly enjoyed this, and last December he rode at the Olympic International Sports Jumping Championships in which he partnered Joan Bullen.

#### JIMMY MARSHALL



I suppose you could say he was born with comedy in his blood, for Jimmy Marshall's father was the old Scots comedian Jock Duncan. But not even Jock would have forecast that one day, Jimmy would be one of the most sought after entertainers in the comedy field.

After years in the 'limbo' of performing in Social clubs throughout the country, Jimmy was discovered by Bernard Delfont during a charity performance at Blackpool and was immediately offered every artistes ambition, The London Palladium. He grabbed the opportunity and was an outstanding success on the Cliff Richards Show. From then he has worked with many of the great names of the entertainment world, including: Englebert Humperdink, Ken Dodd, Buddy Greco, Tommy Cooper, Peter Gordeno, Roy Orbison, Tony Christie, Billy Eckstine and The Beach Boys.

Seasonal bookings have included leading theatrical venues like the A.B.C. in Blackpool in 1968, A.B.C. Gt. Yarmouth, 1969, The Floral Hall in Scarborough in 1971 and 1972. He starred at the Palladium for six months with 'The Comedians', Summer 1973 he topped the bill at the Ocean Theatre, Clacton for fourteen weeks. But it was surely 'The Comedians' Television programme which made the Marshall lad a household name and he has had many many showings on this top viewer rating show. Other television programmes that he has appeared on have included The Black and White Minstrel Show, Will the real Mike Yarwood Stand up?, Comedians Christmas Party, Saturday Variety, It's Lulu, The Lena Martell Show, Comedy from the Talk of the Town, Comedians Music Hall, Look Who's Talking and Saturday Stars. He has frequent radio broadcasts and been special guest star on Peter Murrays' 'Open House'.

Pantomime has also embraced Jimmy Marshall and he has appeared at the Coventry Theatre with Jimmy Clitheroe in 'Humpty Dumpty' in 1968/69, as well as with Vince Hill and Barbara Windsor at The Royal Court, Liverpool in 1971/72.
